Pinaceae – Pinus by cone

- P. strobus White spots and no armature, cone longer than wide
- P. virginiana Purple lines, heavy spine, smooth apophis
- P. sylvestris Faint purple, no spines, thicker apophis
- P. rigida Turbinate flat bottom, stout spine
- P. echinata Thin scale, tiny prickle, hardly armed and egg shaped
- P. pungens Very heavy spine, thick apophis, flat bottom
- P. taeda Hurts to squeeze, outwardly curved spine, pale brown, smooth apophis
- P. elliottii Chocolaty varnished look, wrinkled apophis
- P. palustris Large cone, small prickle
- P. flexilis Orangish-brown
- P. ponderosa (2-5 needles per fascicle) small cone
